Miller Knox Regional Park is a 260 acre grassy area dotted with trees, trails, picnic benches, parking lots and a beautiful lake. At all times of year there are shore birds and squirrels to amuse the visitors. There is no entrance fee. The park is named for US Representative George Miller and California Assemblyman John Knox, both avid supporters of the Regional Park concept.

Please meet us at 10 am and again at 1 pm for display and critique at the 1st (northern) parking lot where restrooms are close by. It's near #2 on the [map](#). Bring your bag lunch. If you need, you could pick up food in Point Richmond, a short drive from the park.

Directions:

From Berkeley/Oakland

Take I-580 West toward San Rafael.

Exit at Canal Boulevard.

Turn Left at the light onto Canal.

Turn Right on W Cutting Blvd.

Turn Left at the stop sign onto Gerrard Blvd.

Proceed through the auto tunnel.

Gerrard becomes Dornan Drive on the south side of the auto tunnel.

The park entrance will be on the right less than ½ mile south of the tunnel.

From I-80 North

Take ramp onto I-80 West.

Turn Right onto Richmond Parkway

Turn Right onto S. Garrard Blvd.

Proceed through the auto tunnel.

Gerrard becomes Dornan Drive on the south side of the auto tunnel.

The park entrance will be on the right less than ½ mile south of the tunnel
