ENTRIES: Two paintings may be submitted by each member. Entry fee is now \$30 for up to two paintings. To enter, log into our website, go to the Member's Home Page and then click on the lower right link. Original, recent water media on paper or Yupo. No copies and no class work. Paintings must be framed in metal or wood, covered with Plexiglas, wired and ready to hang. No sawtooths, clamps or screw eyes. Flat brackets are required on wood frames. No cardboard or masking tape. No wide or Rococo frames. White or off white mats only. The minimum frame size is 16"x20" and the maximum size is 48" x 48" for this show".

Alameda Free Library reserves the right to refuse to exhibit any work of art which it determines, in its sole discretion, to be unsuitable to this setting, including nudes or any subject which could be construed as being of a religious or political nature. If, for any reason, your painting is not included in the show, we will call you after judging and make arrangements for you to pick up your painting.

LABELS: Please print labels from the website. They can be found under the Membership tab, then "forms", and then "Labels to be on paintings submitted to shows". Follow the instructions on the labels when you tape them to the back of your paintings.

SALES: All sales will be made through the artist. All paintings must hang for the duration of the show. The artist is then responsible for a 15% outreach donation to CWA.

INSURANCE: Your paintings will be handled however, CWA and the Alameda Free Library and their volunteers assume no responsibility for theft, loss or damage of any kind. Insurance is the sole responsibility of the artist.
