# March Guest Artist Robin Purcell, AWS, NWS



California has always been a mythic land of sunshine that stirred my imagination. A fortunate set of influences helped me arrive at my own style of interpreting the California Landscape. I was probably permanently warped by doing paint by numbers as a child. I fell hard for the work of the early California Impressionists, particularly Granville Redmond and William Wendt. Their work helped me to see the landscape as shapes. It is much easier for me to control hard edges with watercolor while painting outdoors. These factors led me to develop a style that simplifies what I see and organizes it into shimmering patches of color. I am a Plein Air Painter who goes outside to see colors and shapes from life so that I can change them in ways feel true to me and express my personal artistic vision.

Did you see the SF deYoung Exhibition featuring David Hockney? Many pieces were BIG, REPETITIOUS, and surprisingly INNOVATIVE. It stirred some ahhh haaaa thoughts as I reflected on the CWA Bylaws.

CWA Bylaws ...to further the understanding and appreciation of water media art.... the management of the Association shall be vested in the Board...

Why does **Big + Exhibition = Bylaws?** Many exhibitions encourage us to evaluate and appreciate art from new and different perspectives. Often, the art on display tempts us with a better understanding of how the artist painted the same repetitious scene into a fresh and unique exhibition filled with many pieces. The open-minded approach is not stagnate - old rules are retained or changed - new methods are incorporated. The successful artist stays up to date with innovative ideas and finds the path to a satisfying finish. Sometimes, modern technology assists with the artistic resolution.

Okay, so what does that have to do with our Bylaws? The Board realizes that modern technology is available and assisting CWA today. Our Bylaws, Policies and Procedures need review in order to match how this organization currently functions. The big job of evaluating the old Bylaws is under way to make sure they are up to date, not stagnate or repetitious, changed if necessary and new methods are recognized. It has a vested interest in managing the Association in an innovative way. 2014 Bylaw updates will be ready in the near future. Stay tuned for the revisions.





Larry Cannon's watercolor "A Walk on Aliso Beach" has been accepted for the California Art Club's 103rd Annual Gold Medal Juried Exhibition at the Autry National Center in Los Angeles beginning on March 30. The Gold Medal jury was composed of five museum directors and curators plus seven signature members of the CAC. Larry has also been selected to be on the painting faculty for the Third Annual Plein Air Convention & Expo to be held April 7 - 11 in Monterey. Last year, over 600 artists from around the U.S. attended the event, and more are expected this year with the addition of special watercolor and pastel tracks.
