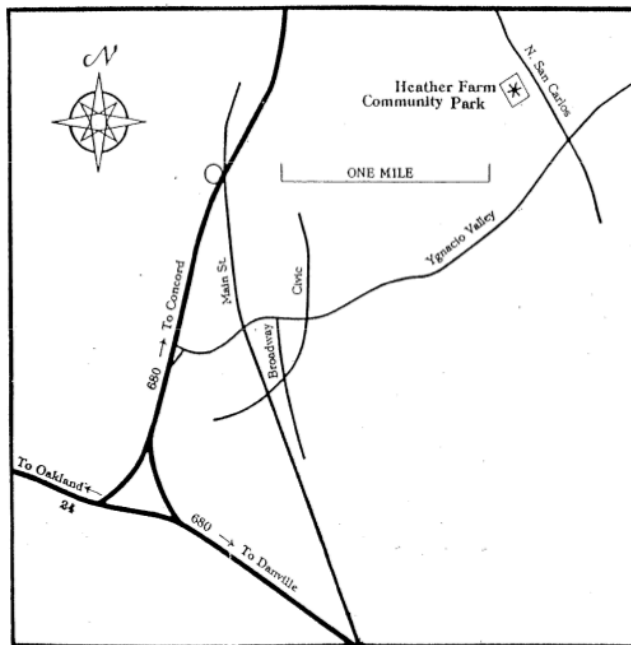


Heather Farm Park N. San Carlos Drive at Heather Drive Walnut Creek, CA

Join CWA at Heather Farm Park, the largest community park in Walnut Creek. The park features a variety of activities and amenities, including the following locales just waiting to be painted: a pond, a lake, a riparian nature area, formal gardens, a gazebo, grasslands, oak woodlands, and of course, people and Canada geese.



From the 680 Freeway, exit at Ygnacio Valley Road; head east towards Mt. Diablo. Stay on Ygnacio Valley Road to the eleventh traffic signal (one block past John Muir Medical Center), and turn left onto North San Carlos. You are now in Heather Farm Park. The Community Center is two blocks down on your left.
