This Show Only—Special Image/Frame Size Limits

The Village Theater Art Gallery is able to accommodate a limited number of small paintings and has capped the maximum size to half-sheet paintings. **Adhere to these framing limits carefully.**

Minimum image: no less than 6" on one side." Minimum frame: no less than 10" on one side." (10"x13" is a standard frame size.)

Maximum outside frame: 20" x 28." (for half sheet 15" x 22" paintings.)

Accepted Entries

Accepted work must match the submitted image; paintings not consistent with submitted image will be disqualified.

Surprise BONUS !!!

Each selected artist in this show can bring two additional water media paintings that do not have to be those that they submitted for selection. They must be originals, not prints, and must conform to the size requirements of this show (see above). They must be matted (per the specs in this document) and must each be in a clear plastic sleeve protector. They will be displayed in the print racks in the gallery and will be for sale. Please be sure to fill out a CWA Show Form and tape it to the back of each matted painting (INSIDE) the plastic envelope.

Framing

All paintings must be framed in simple, square-cornered frames ready for hanging and protected under acrylic (not glass) with foam core backing, wire ends taped and ready to hang. No sawtooths, clamps or eye screws. Mats (optional) must be white or off white. Colored liner mats are acceptable.

CWA Show Form and VTAG loan agreement

It is **VERY** important to include the CWA Show form to the upper left side on the back (foam core) of your framed painting. You can find the form on the CWA website under the Membership tab, then Forms. Fill out all three sections and tape the top edge **only** to the back (foam core) part of your frame.

Please fill out the attached Village Theater Art Gallery loan agreement and bring it with you when delivering your work. You can use one VTAG form for all of your paintings.

Sales

All sales will be made through the gallery. All paintings must remain for the duration of the show. The Village Theater Art Gallery will retain a

40% commission on all work sold.

Conditions and Liabilities

No work may be withdrawn before the end of the Show. CWA and Village Theater Art Gallery reserve the right to photograph artwork and reception crowd or copy images for promotional purposes. Village Theater Art Gallery provides insurance for the artwork while it is in their possession. The submission of entries to this show shall constitute an agreement on the part of the artist to the terms and conditions as set forth in this prospectus..
