September Demo Artist Jean Pederson



"I try not to set boundaries for my work, but open doors through which discovery takes place," says Jean Pederson, our September guest artist. Those open doors have led to a successful career as a professional artist, as well as to the exploration of a wide range of media which she incorporates into her paintings to create rich layers, textures, and effects. Jean's traditional practice includes referential imagery of people, still life, landscape and abstraction.

The layering of a variety of media offers Jean an assortment of possibilities within her work; quality of edge, line and texture all play a role within her imagery. Although Jean is well known for her mastery of watercolors, mixed media has become an important venue for her creative expression. Jean notes that, "We are hard pressed to find a period in time when the human figure wasn't represented. Finding a way to express the human figure in a language that reflects the twenty-first century is perhaps the greatest challenge in figurative work today." The portraits in her paintings are based on people whom she has met or been impacted by. Subjects often reflect different walks of life as well as diverse cultural and religious backgrounds.

Jean's upcoming book, "Mixed Media Painting Workshop," demonstrates her techniques for working with media, as well as her approach to drawing, which is that all subjects can be broken down into circles, triangles, squares, and rectangles, including the human face and figure. Her other book published by North Light, is "Expressive Portraits: Watercolor and Mixed Media Techniques." She is a contributing editor for The Artist's Magazine and her work has appeared in several of the Splash best-of-watercolor series as well as Wa-

tercolor Artist, MagazineArt and many others. She has also released 4 educational dvd's. Check out this link on YouTube to see a preview of one on glazing: www.youtube.com/watch?v=kRSt8wuREpg

Honored with numerous National and International awards over the years, Jean has work in the Royal Collection in Winsor, England. She was the first recipient of the Federation of Canadian Artists Early Achievement Award and she was awarded the Queens Diamond Jubilee Medal for contribution to the arts. Jean has exhibited her work in museums and galleries in Jianguo China, London, England, Stockholm, Sweden, New York, United Nations, San Francisco, Mexico and across Canada. Included in Canada's Who's Who, Jean is a signature member of the American Watercolor Society (AWS), California Watercolor Association (MCWA), The Federation of Canadian Artists (SFCA), the Canadian Society of Painters in Watercolor (CSPWC) and the Alberta Society of Artists (ASA).

Exploring outside her traditional practices, Jean completed a unique body of work for Public Exhibitions dealing with the changes that have occurred within the social fabric of Rural Canada's prairies and landscape. This body of work encompasses paintings, collage and installations, using fragments from the past and present. She included old documents such as receipts to symbolize all that is left of her family farm, along with fragments of the homestead such as linoleum, doors, moldings, shingles, and Polaroid transfers of old and new photographs to tell the story. The fragments represent all that is left from 100 years of farming in her family. This body of work is as eclectic as the people who made up the rural society. "Farm Fragments" is currently traveling to a variety of Public Galleries in Canada.

Loving to teach and facilitate student artists, as well as write, while maintaining a full-time studio practice,



2013 CWA WORKSHOPS SERIES

Jean Pederson "Faces & Figures in Water Media"



**September 16-20/Intermediate-Advanced
California State University East Bay
4700 Ygnacio Valley Road, Concord**

Jean Pederson has been painting for over twenty years, balancing her strong teaching abilities and writing with her continuing aspiration to convey her ideas in visual form. She has exhibited her work in China, England, Sweden, New York, San Francisco, Mexico and across Canada, and is the author of "Expressive Portraits: Creative Methods for Painting People;" North Light Books has approved her to write a second book and she has been honored with numerous national and international awards.

Jean's workshop will open the door into the exploration of various combinations of mixed media with an emphasis on water soluble paints and mediums as they relate to the human face and figure. You will be supported and encouraged to work beyond your traditional practice in pursuit of your own personal language. Jean will help you explore how everything from watercolor to gouache, gesso, acrylics, inks, mark making tools, collage and much more can be applied to figure painting. She will emphasize design and personal style and you will have the opportunity to paint live models. CWA member \$475, non-CWA \$530. Lian Zhen "Chinese Brush & Watercolor Painting"

October 14-18/All Levels

Lian Zhen obtained a BA from the University of California and a Master of Architecture Degree from MIT after immigrating to the US from China. He has exhibited in the US, Hong Kong and China, and his paintings hang in numerous institutional and private collections, including the MIT Museum.

An experienced instructor, Lian has taught watercolor and Chinese brush painting throughout the US, as well as in Europe, Canada, Mexico, the Bahamas, China, South Africa and Australia. He has also juried a number of exhibitions and his paintings have been featured in many magazines and books. His three books on Chinese painting techniques have been distributed internationally.

Lian's workshop will include one day of Chinese brush painting, followed by four days of watercolor. On the Chinese painting day, students will learn about Asian Art theory, how to use Chinese brushes, ink and colors, and painting techniques for spontaneous-style Chinese paintings. (Note that Chinese painting supplies will be available at the workshop for a modest fee.) During the watercolor session, Lian will teach techniques including his "Color Pouring and Blending," as well as composition and coloring. CWA member \$495, non-CWA \$550. 




Her paintings have received awards from more than 75 national and international watercolor exhibitions, and she was an invited participant in the Second and Third International Exhibition of Contemporary International Watermedia Masters in Nanjing, China, as well as the 2010 Shanghai Zhujiajiao International Watercolour Biennial Exhibition in Shanghai, China. Ms. Daily-Birnbaum was a juror of selection for the 2011 AWS International Exhibition and the chairperson for the selection jury for the 2012 NWS Annual Exhibition.

Venue

Founded in the 1960s, the Olive Hyde Art Gallery is located in the historic Mission San Jose area of Fremont, originally home of the Ohlone Indians. The Gallery was one of several buildings erected in the 1940s by Miss Olive Hyde. In 1962 she donated the buildings to the City of Fremont to be used for cultural and recreational purposes. Miss Hyde, member of a prominent San Francisco family, strongly supported the arts and wanted to preserve the history

and atmosphere of Mission San Jose. The Gallery's charm and rustic simplicity make it a favorite showcase for Bay Area artists and traveling exhibits.

Eligibility

The CWA 44th National Exhibition is open to all artists 18 years or older. Paintings must be two-dimensional and primarily of water-based media on paper surface; watercolor canvas, Yupo, and Tyvek are acceptable. Pastel or collage may be used as long as **watermedia is the dominant element**. No digital media, photography, prints, or reproductions. Source material and composition must be wholly original and not derived from any published images. Entries must be recent works completed within the last two years, entirely the work of the artist, and not shown previously in a CWA National Exhibition. No workshop or class work allowed. Artists who fail to provide an accepted entry are disqualified from the next three CWA National Exhibitions.

Size Limits

Minimum image: 140 square inches, no side less than 10 inches
Maximum outside frame: 40"x40"
Maximum weight: 40 lbs.

Framing

All paintings must be framed in simple, square-cornered frames ready for hanging and protected under Plexiglas. Mats (optional) must be white or off white. Colored liner mats are acceptable. Additional details will be included in instructions to accepted artists.

Online Entries Only

To enter, go to www.californiawatercolor.org, click "Shows/Exhibitions," then "National Prospectus" for online submission details. Artists may enter up to three digital images in jpeg format, resolution 300 dpi, with 1200 pixels on the longest side, one painting per file. Show only the image without mat or frame. Entry Fees (non-refundable)

Entry fee is payable on PayPal by credit, debit, or individual account. CWA members: \$35 for one image, \$5 each additional image, maximum three. Non-members: \$45 for one image, plus \$5 each additional image, maximum three. Those wishing to join CWA may add \$45 annual dues during the entry process.

Accepted Entries

All accepted artists will be notified by email and results will be posted online November 14, 2013. Artists with accepted artwork may be asked for a higher resolution image for the catalog. Shipping instructions will be attached to the acceptance email. All accepted paintings will have a handling fee of \$45. Accepted work must match submitted image; paintings not consistent with submitted image may be disqualified. All accepted paintings will be represented in the catalog. Each Exhibition entrant will receive a complimentary catalog. Additional catalogs will be available for purchase.

Sales

The Olive Hyde Art Gallery, in conjunction with the City of Fremont, will handle all painting sales and retain a 40 percent commission.

Conditions and Liabilities

No work may be withdrawn before the end of the exhibit. CWA and the Olive Hyde Art Gallery reserve the right to photograph artwork or copy images for promotional purposes. Insurance coverage is the artist's sole responsibility, both in transit and during the exhibit. Neither CWA nor the Olive Hyde Art Gallery insures the artwork and neither shall be responsible for loss or damage to any artwork submitted. Accepted artists must sign a release of liability. The submission of entries to this competition shall constitute an agreement on the part of the artist to the terms and conditions as set forth in this prospectus.


