







# The Drawing Board

## California Watercolor Association

Each month, a different member of the CWA Board of Directors will have the opportunity to write an art-related article for our members.

### Curated Watercolor Tutorial YouTube Channels

My art journey was not a typical one. I never felt artistically talented or creative and could not draw a straight line. My only formal art class was an elective I took in junior high that only confirmed that I was not creative or talented. It did make me envy those who were seemingly gifted at drawing and painting and whose art made my work look like stick figures compared with theirs. When I did decide to pursue a hobby in art I was fortunate enough to live in the digital age, in a time when anything you can think of can be researched on the internet and someone has created a how-to YouTube video on the subject. I visited websites, and Wiki Pages and watched countless hours of YouTube videos. In fact, enough hours of video to qualify for a degree in art if I were taking a course. I love the commitment of thousands of artists and teachers who have taken the time and their passion to make educational content and, in most cases, have provided it to us for free! Once I went down the rabbit hole, I couldn't stop watching tutorials, and demos. I watched videos on oil, pastel, acrylic, and watercolor. I also watched



informative videos on color theory, composition, classic oil techniques, the changing art periods, and documentaries on well-known artists. Very often when hosting a workshop for CWA I find myself talking about where I may have seen a technique or a demo that would help a student with a concept the artist may be talking about and will share links to some of my favorite videos and tutorial sites. Below are some of my favorite artists and channels.

**Word of caution:** It's very easy to spend all your time watching videos about learning how to paint. Make sure you stop watching and pick up a brush!

**Hint:** Once you land on an Artist's YouTube homepage, click on the videos tab to see all of their videos then click on the playlist to see how they have organized them. The organizational lists may help you find the content you are looking for. Clicking on the about tab will usually show you links to the artist's website and other social media sites.

*Nature Journaling*

I can't say enough about John Muir Laws. He is a wonderful instructor on watercolor, journaling, and art. He is also extremely knowledgeable about natural history. Each of his videos is like a college course on the subject you are going to learn to paint. If it's painting a bird, you will learn about the skeleton, the wing structure, feathers, and tricks on how to quickly draw and paint one in the field. If you are going to paint wildflowers, you will learn the structure of a flower, how to draw the flower, and if it's a cylinder shape or round shape, and what happens to those shapes when you look at them from different angles. All of his videos are complete lectures lasting an hour or more!

Take Hwy. 101 north across the Golden Gate Bridge. Take exit 442, merge onto Alexander Avenue; bear right. Turn left on Danes avenue, continue straight on Bunker Road through tunnel. Head towards the ocean, and park near the beach.




