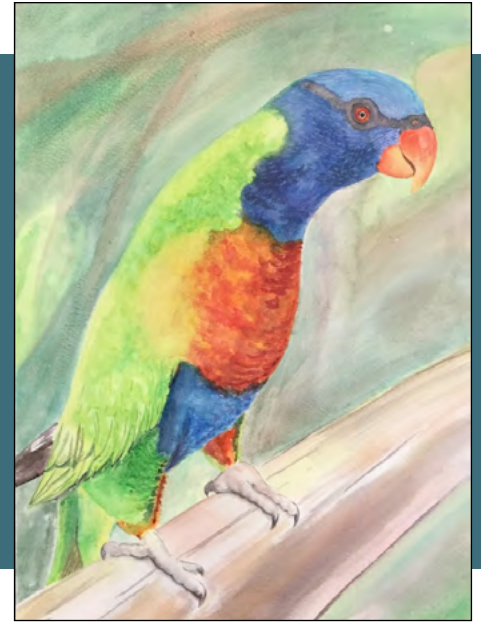




# Community Outreach

### CWA has juried the students’ work and chosen the winners.

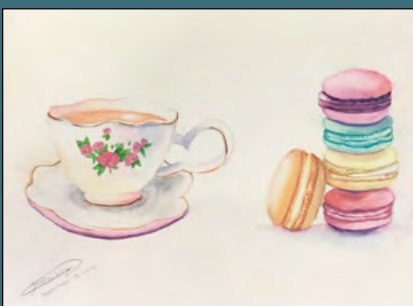
The winner for the 11th-12th grade is *Place of Peace* by Isaya Chou.
