outreach in Glendale, Charlotte Huntley Teaches 32 4th Graders

On December 7, 2012 Charlotte Huntley, MCWA, AWS taught watercolor painting to a classroom of 4th grade students at Holy Family Grade School in Glendale, California. The students painted the horizontally banded format she demonstrated. Then she challenged them to add an object in the middle. For example, if they liked cars, they could put a car in the middle. Alternatively they could do the 4 Seasons with the 4 bands. Charlotte found she had to be vigilant as the students often used too little water. They had not had the pleasure of using tube style pigments previously. 31 of the 32 completed most of their painting and they were placed in line in the hallway outside of the room for everyone to enjoy.
