



Plein Air – Crab Cove, Alameda

Saturday, July 20, 2019, 10:00am to 1:30pm



We can meet at 10 am at the end of McKay Avenue near the beach and then spread out and paint. There are picnic tables near there in the grassy area where we can meet again at 1:30pm to share what we've done. Bring a bag lunch.

From Cities to the North:

Take I-80 West to I-880 South and take the Broadway exit. Turn right at the light onto 5th Street. Stay on 5th Street following the signs to Alameda. Go through the Webster Street Tunnel (Tube) to Alameda. See in Alameda below.

From Cities to the South:

Take I-880 North. Exit at Broadway in Oakland. Turn right on Broadway, right on 7th Street, and right on Webster. Go through the Webster Street Tunnel (Tube) to Alameda. See in Alameda below.

From Walnut Creek:

Take Highway 24 West to I-980, towards downtown Oakland. Exit at 12th/11th Streets. Continue on Brush Street to 5th Street. Turn left on 5th Street and stay in the left lanes, following the signs to Alameda. Go through the Webster Street Tunnel (Tube) to Alameda. See in Alameda below.

In Alameda:

Continue on Webster Street across town. Turn right on Central Ave., go one block, and turn left onto McKay Ave. (at Foster's Freeze). Crab Cove is at the end of McKay on the left.
