The former ranch of early Walnut Creek pioneer Frank Borges is the home base for Walnut Creek's Shell Ridge Open Space activities. The ranch complex includes a blacksmith shop, numerous outbuildings, and farm equipment displays. It also features a barn and covered trellis available for group reservations. The Borges family home, built in 1901, houses historical displays of the early 1900's. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Meet at 10 am in the parking lot at the first picnic area and we'll decide where to meet for lunch and critique at 1:30 pm in the shady picnic area.

Park in designated areas; restrooms available; bring water and lunch.

Directions:

Start at Gallery Concord on Galindo - go toward LAGUNA ST - go 0.4 mi

1. Continue on MONUMENT BLVD - go 1.0 mi
2. Turn Left on OAK GROVE RD - go 3.5 mi
3. Continue on CASTLE ROCK RD - go 1.0 mi
4. Arrive at 1035 CASTLE ROCK RD, WALNUT CREEK, on the Right

From Walnut Creek and Ygnacio Valley Road:

Heading East on Ygnacio Valley Rd from the City of Walnut Creek, Turn Right on WALNUT AVE 1. Turn Right on STONEHAVEN DR - go 0.4 mi

2. Turn Left on BOWLING GREEN DR

3. Turn Right on CASTLE ROCK RD - go 0.8 mi

4. Arrive at 1035 CASTLE ROCK RD, WALNUT CREEK, on the Right
