Mile-long Baker Beach lies at the foot of rugged cliffs west of the Golden Gate Bridge on the shore of the Pacific Ocean to the northwest of the city. It provides panoramic views of the ocean, bridge, Marin headlands and Lands End. Large outcrops of grey-green serpentine cliffs occur along this coast that support some rare plant species. There is a picnic area with tables, grills, drinking water next to the parking lot and restrooms at the SSW end of the parking lot. Trails lead to the beach from the NNE end of the lot. Meet at the picnic tables. Weather can be foggy, cold and windy or warm and sunny! Bring lunch.

From the Bay Bridge: Merge onto US 101 N turnoff onto Central Fwy, onto Octavia Blvd. L onto Fell St, **R onto Stanyan St, L onto Fulton, R onto 25th Ave, R onto El Camino Del Mar. Continue onto Lincoln Blvd, *L onto Bowley St, take 1st R onto Gibson Rd. Take 1st R onto Battery Chamberlin Rd into parking lot.

From Marin: Head S on 101 over bridge and exit toward 25th Ave. Merge onto Merchant Rd, R onto Lincoln Blvd and follow ** directions above.

From the peninsula: Take 101 N to Central Freeway to Fell Street and follow directions above.

“FYI” NNW end of Baker Beach is frequented by clothing-optional sunbathers.
